Dear Pickaway County Registered Septage Haulers:

Enclosed you will find the application to register to provide services as a septage hauler in Pickaway County Public Health. **Your application must include the following:**

1. Registration Application along with septage hauler registration fees. Check fees for business fee and truck fee.
2. Proof of passing the Testing Requirements.
3. Proof of compliance with any system specific training, qualification, or certification required as a condition of a system's approval by the director.
4. Proof of General Liability insurance of not less than \$500,000 (**Original to be filed with Ohio Department of Health** and a **copy** provided with your registration application).
5. Proof of surety bond (**to be filed with Ohio Department of Health** and a **copy** provided with your registration application).
6. Proof of 6.0 hours or more of ODH approved continuing education credits completed during the previous calendar year to count for the licensing year you are applying to do work.
7. **Any outstanding forms, required pumping reports, service records, or other documentation for all work completed in previous calendar year that have not been submitted to the local health district. Failure to submit all required reports will result in disapproval of your registration.**

Registration will not be approved until all of the above documents are submitted to our office and The Ohio Department of Health has received and approved your bonding. We are requiring all of the above documents to be submitted along with your application to prevent disapproval of your registration, and any of the above mentioned paperwork not included will result in everything being returned to you.

Please remember, registration must be approved prior to conducting any work or performing services of septage hauling in Pickaway County in the licensing year.

You can contact our office to schedule truck inspections at 740-477-9667 ext. 225. **If you have already had your truck(s) inspected by your home county, we will accept those inspections. Please send inspections with your application.**
